



## USS Batfish & USS Oklahoma Amateur Radio Club Meeting Location: Muskogee War Memorial Park Meeting Minutes April 06, 2024

The April 6th, 2024 Batfish & Oklahoma Amateur Radio Club meeting was a combination of in-person and Zoom. Total attendance was 12, consisting of 9 in-person and 3 Zoom. The requirements for a quorum were met. Mike Manring called the meeting to order at 10:03 local time.

Minutes of the March 2nd, 2024 meetings were read. A motion to accept the minutes was made, seconded, and passed.

The Treasurer reported that the Club has a Cash-On-Hand balance of \$2,049.13.

## **Old Business:**

- 1) Jim Erb gave an update of the Museum status. The new AT&T internet system is working, it has a 15 port hub, the advertised speed is 15 Mb, the measured speed today is 11 Mb down and 5 Mb up. Some carpentry work is needed for repair of the picnic tables the Club had built and maintained. Some of the tables might need to be replaced.
- 2) Repairs to the tower trailer were discussed. The tower was painted in time for the Green Country Hamfest in Claremore. Batteries for the trailer were extensively discussed. There was no clear consensus for what type of batteries, how many batteries, and when or even if the battery change should be made in the near future. It was decided to forestall this decision since there is no immediate change needed.
- 3) Mike is the contact person for any Green Country Hamfest plans, ideas, or questions. It appears that table space will be limited. Wade Harris will be selling a large number of items from the estate of a silent key.
